Center section of the Blueridge features a beautiful open cathedral ceiling with rafter and ridge beams above and knotty pine v-match below. The bedroom wings are done in truss rafters with knotty pine v-match beneath. The upper gable ends of the bedroom wings are designed and shown with log siding on the exterior.

Optional Design Ideas:

Grow the 6' prow sides out to 8' and bring the front wall straight across.

Add an entrance door or window to the left or right of the great room extension


Eliminate the hallway closet and expand the 'Utility Room' into a guest bedroom

Fireplace can move to the front of the home for a spectacular focal point

Change the Frenchwood doors on the front to larger size windows.


Add a Frenchwood door to the Master. Bedroom leading to the deck
